Did you know that you can purchase gift cards for local and national retailers at Bethany—the same gift cards that you can buy at local stores like Giant Eagle?

***Did you know that by purchasing your gift cards from Bethany instead of from other vendors, you can help to support Bethany's missions?***

Just like the gift cards that you purchase at the local stores, the value of the card is exactly the amount you pay. Bethany buys the cards at a small discount, so our profit is built in.
